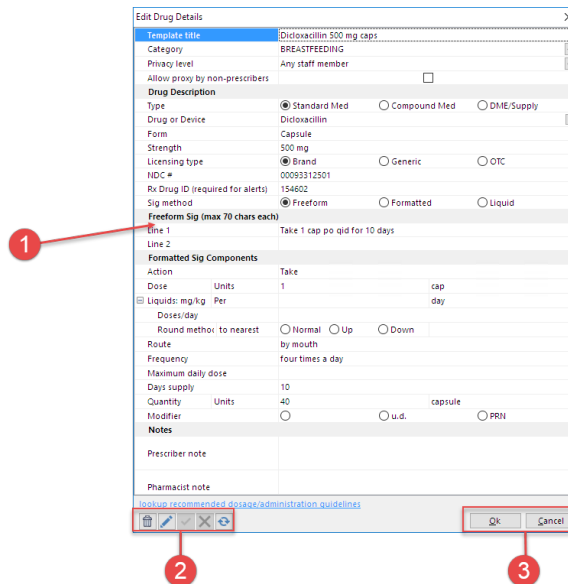
About Edit Drug Details

Path: Clinical tab > Medication Favorites button > double-click medication

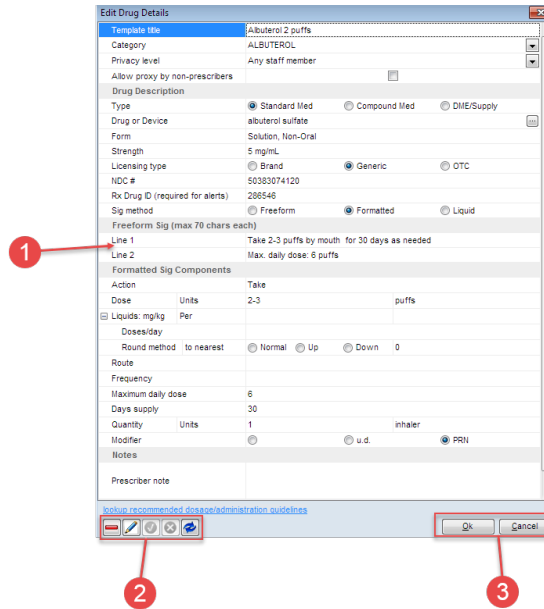
