

Overview

Audit Logs are used to track auditable events in OP as performed by logged-in OP users. They can be viewed for a specific patient or for all patients within a certain date range. The reports available are:

Audit Trail of Changes to Records

The **Audit Trail of Changes to Records** tab displays changes made to a specific table in OP and the reason for the change. The most commonly used function of this tab is to view the before and after changes for a record. To include the before and after changes in the grid, click the **Show/Hide Visible column** button [3] (located to the left of the Date column) and select the **Before Changes** and **After Changes** checkboxes.



When interpreting the codes in the Before Changes and After Changes columns, you may find this set of crosswalks helpful.

Log of Access and Review of Records

The **Log of Access and Review of Records**tab displays actions taken on records, such as when records were viewed or when visit notes were opened or finalized.



Disclosure Tracking

The **Disclosure Tracking** tab displays a log of information that was printed or released from a patient record and the recipient of the information.







Login Statistics

The Login Statistics tab displays staff login time, staff logout time, and workstation information.
