Removing the Emergency Server Designation on a Workstation

If you need to remove the EOS Designation from a Workstation:

1. Right-click the **Start** button, located in the lower-left corner of your Windows screen.
2. Select **Explore**.
3. In the **OP** folder, locate the file labeled **OP911a.txt** and delete this file.
4. In the **OP911/gdb_common** folder, locate the file labeled **OP911b.txt** and delete this file.
5. Open Office Practicum. You will no longer see the pop-up window asking if you want to connect to this machine as the emergency workstation.
6. Open the OPBackUp Scheduler.
7. Right-click the backup job, and select **Edit Job** from the pop-up menu.
8. Click the **Restore** tab and deselect the **Restore the db on this computer after a successful backup** checkbox. Do this for any jobs currently scheduled.
9. Unless space is an issue on the machine, continue the backups on this workstation without the restore.
