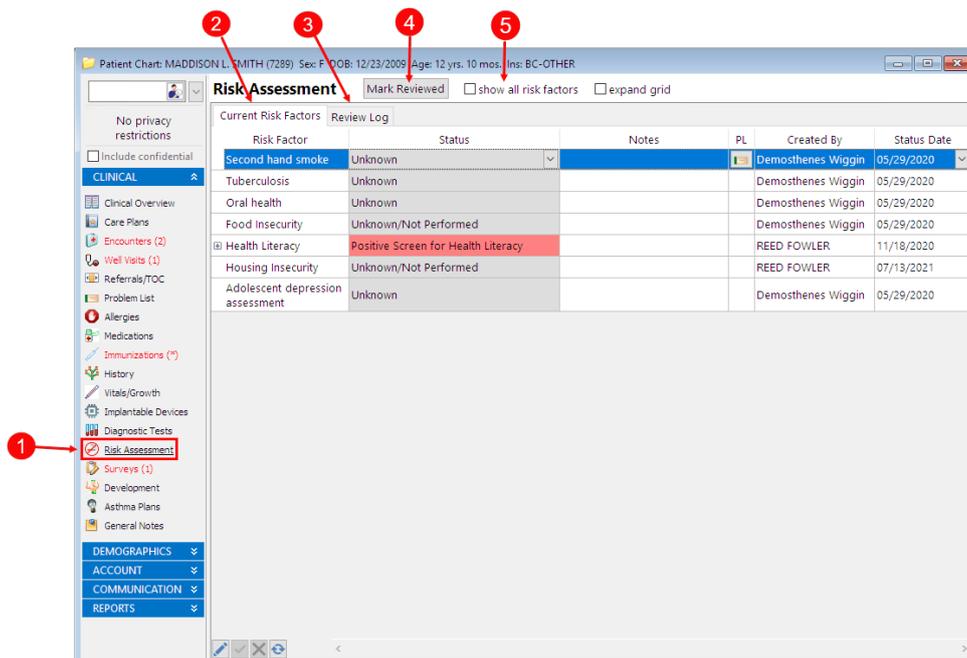
## About Patient Chart: Risk Assessment

**Path: Clinical, Practice Management, or Billing tab > Patient Chart button > Risk Assessment**

Within the Risk Assessment List, you can choose common risk factors and use them in the care plans for your patients. This helps with using OP for Meaningful Use as well as with OP Care Plans.



**Note:** Just like a paper chart, the electronic chart in OP contains personal health information and should be kept protected and confidential. Always close all windows on your screen and log out of OP when you are not at your workstation.



## Patient Chart: Risk Assessment Map

Number	Section	Description
1	Risk Assessment button	The Risk Assessment button accesses the Risk Assessment window in the patient's chart.
2	Current Risk Factors tab	The Current Risk Factors tab displays risk factors based on the child's age.

3	Review Log tab	The Review Log tab displays entries with the name and the date and time that the Mark Reviewed button was selected.
4	Mark Reviewed button	The <b>Mark Reviewed</b> button affirms the status of all risk factors on the risk factor list and marks the risk factors as reviewed.
5	Show all risk factors	The <b>Show All Risk Factors</b> checkbox displays a complete list of Risk Factors in OP. For example, you may need to update a Risk Factor that is not currently displaying for a child due to their current age (i.e. Smoking Status prior to the age of 13).

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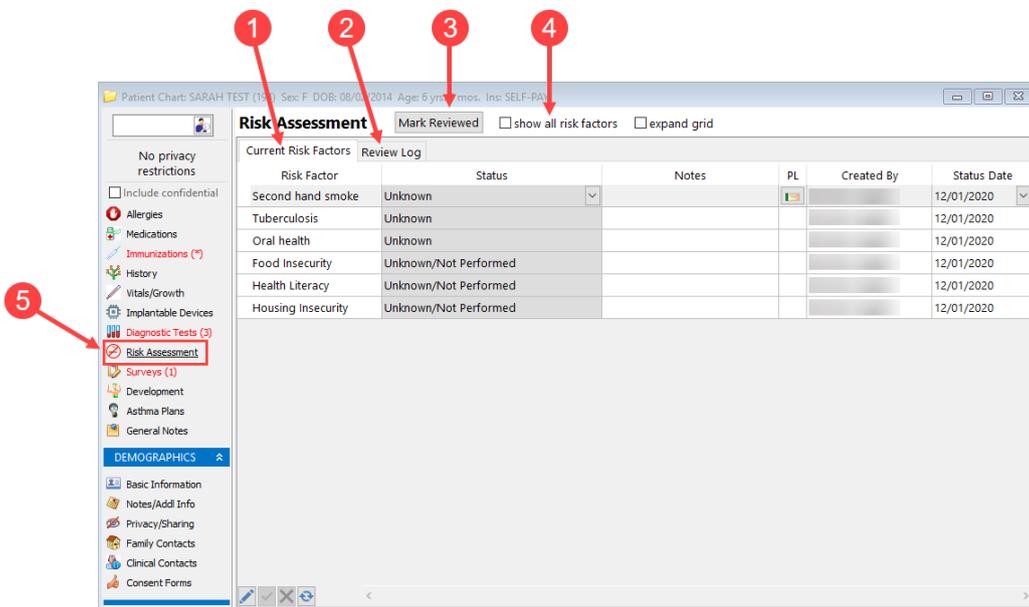
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
