

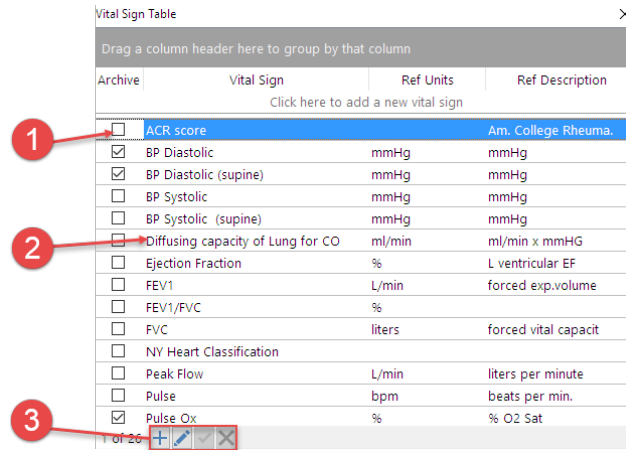
Number	Section	Description
