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

About Well Visit: Graphic

Path: Clinical, Practice Management, or Billing tab > Patient Chart button > Well Visits > New or Open Note button > Graphic

The Graphic window allows images that can be drawn on or annotated to be imported to a Well Visit.

| 1 | Graphic button | The Graphic button accesses the Graphic window in the patient's Well Visit Note. |
| 2 | Well Visit Function buttons | The function buttons delete an entire Well Visit Note, edit a Well Visit Note, or save a Well Visit Note. |
| 3 | Flag as Incomplete checkbox | The Flag as Incomplete checkbox marks the Well Visit Note as unfinished. |
| 4 | Choose button | The Choose button opens the Search for Documents window. From the Search for Documents window, search for and select the document that will appear in the Items panel of the Well Visit: Graphic window. |

| 6 | Finalize buttons | The Finalize buttons are used to sign, apply changes, or cancel changes to an image. |
| 7 | Rotate buttons | The Rotate buttons rotate the displayed image in the preview pane ninety (90 degrees clockwise or counter-clockwise). |
| 8 | Items panel | The Items panel lists the documents that are selected from the Search for Documents window. From this panel, images and documents can be selected to appear in the preview pane for viewing or editing. Selected images in this panel can be edited, deleted, and saved. |
| 9 | Preview pane | The preview pane displays the selected document in the Items pane. The image can be drawn on or annotated. |
| 10 | Item Function buttons | The Item Function buttons are used to delete, edit, save changes, or cancel changes to the selected document in the Items pane. |
| 11 | Document Navigation buttons | The Document Navigation buttons are used to navigate to the first, previous, next, or last page of the document. The document can be zoomed in and out using the buttons as well. |

About Preventive Exam: Graphic Tab



The Preventive Exam window charts a patient well-visit exam. The Preventive Exam window helps to code and complete a preventive encounter visit. The preventive exam note encompasses both narrative and comprehensive formats. It also allows you to customize the layout of the note. The note is added to the patient chart.

The The Graphic tab allows images that can be drawn on or annotated to be imported to an encounter.

| 4 | Care Plans tab | The Care Plans tab lists, prints, and manages care plans for a patient's health maintenance schedule. |
| 5 | Prior Well Visits tab | The Prior Well Visits tab lists the previous preventive exam notes. |
| 6 | Templates tab | The Templates tab lists the templates that are created, edited, and reviewed in the Well Visit Template Editor . Templates are pre-written scenarios you can use in a well visit to document common pediatric diagnoses. Templates include detailed descriptions for the usual pertinent positive and negative findings of a wide variety of illnesses, with a standard assessment, plan and ICD-10 coding. Included with your installation of Office Practicum are Pediatric specific templates. |
