

This report displays all outstanding balances due from the patient, by Location, and breaks the balances up by different aging buckets, making it easy to see, in a quick glance, the areas of work in your A/R that need to be addressed.



**Note**: If patient details indicate a balance in a date range bucket that is different from the top row bucket, then the AR\_AGING\_HISTORY table data is out of date. Re-run the **update** function by clicking the **Update** button in the **Billing tab** > **Proof Patient Accounts** > **A/R Data Update Procedures tab**.


