

Clipping and Saving from the Clip-and-Save SQL Library to the OP Database Viewer is very easy:

- 1. Select the SQL Article from the Clip-and-Save SQL Library for the code you want to copy.
- 2. Click the Copy button in the SQL article. This highlights and copies your Code to your clipboard.
- 3. Click the **Database Viewer** button. The OP Database Viewer is displayed.
- 4. Click the SQL tab.
- 5. Paste the Code in the SQL field.
- 6. Click the Save SQL Query Text Under a New Name button 🔡 .
- 7. Enter a Name for your SQL Query.
- 8. Run your new SQL code.
