

We are currently updating the OP Help Center content for the release of OP 14.19 or "OP 19". OP 19 is a member of the certified OP 14 family of products (official version is 14.19.1), which you may see in your software (such as in Help > About) and in the Help Center tabs labeled 14.19. You may also notice that the version number in content and videos may not match the version of your software, and some procedural content may not match the workflow in your software. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we make these enhancements.

Phase 2: OP Certification Release September 2019

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In September, we will release OP 20 which will be our certified version of OP under the 2015 Edition criteria. It will include all of the [Phase 1](#) feature enhancements plus the following:

Clinical Information Reconciliation

Presently users can import a C-CDA version 1.1 and incorporate data from the Allergy List, Medication List, and Problem List into the patient's chart as a reconciliation of external clinical data. OP 20 will allow users to view and reconcile C-CDA version 2.1 which should resolve some of the issues clients are seeing now when attempting to bring in a C-CDA.

Data Export

Data Export has to do with practice's ability to generate C-CDAs. We will be enhancing the filtering options so that a user can select one or more patients for specific data ranges. Practices will also be able to schedule the export of C-CDAs at a specific time and on a recurring basis.

Transitions of Care (ToC)

ToC has to do with generating a C-CDA and sending it in a referral through Direct Messaging. There will be enhancements to our Direct Messaging functionality making it easier to track message success.
