## Recall Patients Due for Well Visits or Other Follow-Ups

Staying on top of patient recalls is one way to ensure that patients who have health needs requiring follow-up and patients who are due or behind on their Well Visits are receiving the care they need. Use the resources below to run recalls for:

- Visit **Demographic Analysis and Recall Overview** for information on how to print letters, send messages using <u>PMX</u> and export the information.
