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

## About Prescriber Authorization

**Path: Main Navigation bar > Refill Requests > Prescription(s) with Request Type of Prescriber Authorization > Accept/Deny button > Validate button**

The Prescriber Authorization window is prompted by the Validate button located in the eRx Change Summary window for prescriptions where Prescriber Authorization has been requested. This process provides confirms the prescriber's information and is sent to the pharmacy upon clicking the **Validate** button in the window.

## Prescriber Authorization Map

Number	Section	Description
1	Prescriber Information	The Prescriber Information must be completed by the prescriber and sent to the requesting pharmacy.
2	Validate button	The <b>Validate</b> button sends the prescriber information to the requesting pharmacy.
3	Cancel button	The <b>Cancel</b> button exits the Prescriber Authorization window and does not complete the pharmacy request for Prescriber Authorization.
