


How can I enter the Vaxelis vaccine?

For practices who have received the Vaxelis vaccine in their office, please be aware that the Vaccine Product (DTaP-HepB-IPV-HIB) that this represents already exists in your OP!


Our practices in the Caribbean have been using the hexavalent product Infanrix for several years, which is the same combination of products and the same CVX code. Navigate to your **Vaccine Product** table, change the Inventory name, and add the Product Description, GTIN (if available), and NDCID.
