About

Bi-directional Immunization Information Systems (IIS) allow the Practice to not only send immunization information to the state's Immunization Registry but also to sync registry information and pull it into OP. This alleviates the Practice's need to manually enter information that was previously reported to the state's Immunization Registry, for example, by the patient's previous care provider.

Sync and Import Registry Information Workflow

NAVIGATE	SYNC	REVIEW / RECONCILE	SELECT + IMPORT
Navigate to the Immunizations section of the patient's chart: Clinical, Practice Management, or Billing tab > Patient Chart button > Immunizations.	Click the Sync Registry button to retrieve and display the patient's immunization information from the registry.	Review the information. The Color Key at the bottom of the window will help you decide what to import into OP.	Click Select All to import all information into OP or select the checkbox(es) for the individual lines to import into OP. Then, click the Import button.
